PREVENTING SLIPS AND FALLS DURING THE WINTER SEASON

All slips and falls are preventable with a little planning and forethought. The ability to avoid a slip, trip or fall depends heavily on your attention to your surroundings, what you have on your feet, and what you're doing in the moment.

SURFACE-

If we encounter icy or snowy conditions in our travels, here is what we can do about it:

- Sand, salt and shovels are located by all the entrances- a little time spent may prevent an injury.
- If walkways or guest units need shoveling - reach the Storm Crew on radio channel 4 or by emailing the request to snowshoveling@jaypeakresort.com
- Plowing needs should be reported to Security on radio channel 1, or by calling **802-323-6523**; Security can then relay information to our snowplow operators.

ATTENTION -

Our own behaviors and preparedness can have the greatest influence on our safety

FOOTWEAR -

Everyone should own and wear appropriate winter boots when walking outside.
