


A HEAD'S UP FOR UPHILLERS A SAFETY REMINDER SO NO ONE LOSES THEIR HEAD



Jay Peak Resort strongly discourages the use of our trails during non-operational hours due to the use of a winch and other snow grooming, snowmaking, snowmobile traffic, and other pre-operational activities. There are no rescue services available at these times.

Should you choose not to heed this warning, some commonsense notes:

- \rightarrow Wear reflective clothing and a headlamp so you are visible to our on-mountain operators.
- \rightarrow Winch cat operations may be happening any night and pose the threat of serious injury

or death to anyone who comes into contact with the cable. The cable may not always be visible; it can be buried in the snow and hard to detect.

- \rightarrow Do not, at any time, ski or ride in front, behind, or anywhere near a groomer. Consider not just the potential danger to yourself, but also our operators.
- \rightarrow Only use the designated uphill routes identified on the Jay Peak trail map. Winch cat grooming can be anywhere on the mountain at any time EXCEPT these designated routes.
